KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

This position works independently but as part of a small team to provide support for the delivery of the Design and Technologies classes. Duties include, but are not limited to:

- ➤ The sourcing / ordering of materials, parts, machinery, tools and equipment.
- > The preparation of materials and equipment for the practical component of the lessons.
- > Carrying out weekly Workplace Safety checks on all equipment and machinery or organising these repairs through an external provider.
- > To maintain and monitor stock control.
- To provide technical support to staff / students during lesson time as required.
- Maintenance of machinery and equipment in accordance with relevant Workplace Safety requirements and other applicable legislation, regulations and standards.
- Ensure hand tools are kept in optimum condition.
- > General housekeeping and storage of projects and equipment to allow for a safe, clean, and efficient environment for staff and students to work in.
- > The handling and storage of raw materials, sometimes in large quantities, following deliveries.
- > Assist with operational aspects including policy, procedures, maintenance, and security.
- Maintain a clean and organised workshop and resource area.

Workplace Health and Safety

- > Demonstrate a commitment to workplace health and safety and ensure that the School complies with all relevant regulatory requirements in regard to the provision of a safe workplace and a professional work environment.
- > Be aware of and follow all workplace health and safety requirements when undertaking work.
- > Be responsible for reporting on all elements of workplace health and safety.

Hours of Work

This is a part-time position (0.5 FTE), based on 19 hours per week. The days and times of work will be dependent on the Design and Technologies timetable.

Generally, hours of work fall between 8.00 am to 4.00 pm Monday to Friday during term time. Some flexibility of hours will be required to facilitate effective input into the Design and Technology learning program.
